They designed galaxies, built bridges, made music, wrote algorithms, and learnt how to be resilient when the algorithms didn't work out first time. Eagle class used Code Monkey, A.L.E.X and Scratch. They worked on creating and debugging programs. The activities were an enormous success and the children enjoyed their learning enormously.
