**OWL CLASS INFORMATION FOR PARENTS**

**Welcome to Owl Class.** The children have settled very quickly into their new class, and have enjoyed exploring our fantastic, large classroom and outdoor area.

The class is taught by Mrs Turk on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday morning and all day on a Thursday and Friday; and by Mrs Tyler on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons.

We have two teaching assistants in Owl class, Mrs Woodcock and Miss Neave. We have an open door policy in our school and if you have any questions, or anything you would like to discuss with us then please come and speak to us; if we can't speak to you immediately then we will make a time to do so as soon as we can.

**Show and Tell:**

The children can bring things in for Show and Tell each Monday. This is a valuable way for the children to develop confidence when speaking to a group. The objects they wish to talk about should be brought in in a bag which is clearly labelled with their name. Try not to bring anything which is valuable to school, and please remember that devices such as iPads or iPods are not allowed.

**Forest Schools and Outdoor Learning:**

Owl class will take part in Forest School and other outdoor learning sessions during the term. Please ensure that your child has a named pair of wellies and a warm coat in school at all times, thank you to those who have already provided these.

**Parent Reading:**

This term, parent reading sessions will take place on Thursday mornings. Please bring your child to the class door as you would normally do and then go to the school office and wait for us to welcome you to the class to share a book with your child to start the day.

**PE:**

PE takes place on a Tuesday and Wednesday. Your child's PE kit should be in school all week, with every item labelled with their name.

**Reading books and home/ school message book:**

We encourage every child to read daily at home. We will aim to change their reading book as soon as it has been read at home so it is really useful for us if you write about your child's reading at home. Your child will also have the chance to choose a book from our well stocked school library every week; please make sure their school library book is kept in their book bag and returned to school every day.

**Homework:**

Reception have a homework sheet from which they can choose activities to complete as they wish. Year One will have homework set each week. Homework will be sent home, along with a short overview of the planned learning for that week on a Monday and needs to be returned the following Monday when a member of staff will have a look at it.

**Newsletters:**

The school newsletter is sent home to every family on a Friday and posted on our school website (<http://aslacton.corvuseducation.com/>). This will give details of special events and other activities that are happening in school, along with details about clubs, lunches and other day to day information.
