Owl and Eagle Africa Alive Trip

We are planning to visit Africa Alive on Thursday 4th July as part of our work on Africa. Both classes are studying core stories that are based in Africa and take into account Miss Knight's visit to Malawi.

We will be travelling by coach, leaving school at 8.45am. This will mean that **children need to be in school at 8.30am this day**. Please bring the children straight to the classroom doors for us to register them.

We will be returning at 3.15pm. **Please collect the children at 3.30pm** from their classrooms.

All children will require a packed lunch, sun hat, waterproof if wet and a separate water bottle to their lunch. Lunches can be ordered on the attached permission form. They will also require a small backpack in which they can carry their lunch and drinks. They will be expected to carry this all day.

All children must be in full school uniform. . Please apply sunscreen before the school day begins.

We will be exploring the zoo and finding out about the different animals that come from the African continent. We also hope to be able to take a ride on the zoo train.

We will be staffing this trip from amongst the school staff.

To enable the trip to go ahead we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £7.90 per child. If we do not get enough contributions to cover the cost then we may have to cancel the trip.

We are very grateful to the PTA for their generous donation towards the cost of the transport for this trip.
