### This week at Aslacton

Eagle class have worked hard on the Platinum Jubilee Posy Project - designing a selection of collage flowers for a Royal competition. We have explored the human geography of Haiti, studying and comparing homes, employment and culture. In English, we have planned and edited our first version of a Caribbean folk tale. The children have considered the setting, characters, story problem, resolution and moral. Great writing and imaginative ideas! In Science, Eagles have worked with enthusiasm to design and build parachutes for their own skydiving company. We had fun testing our product to find the best air resistance. A super week of learning! This week in English, Kestrels have written detailed character profiles about Templeton, the rat from Charlotte's Web. We have reflected on the events of the story and have talked about our likes, dislikes and how the story made us feel. In maths, we have explored finding equivalent fractions by playing games and carrying out investigations. We all really enjoyed our first session playing the samba drums which was led by our visiting music teacher, Mr Woodgate. In Owls we have learned about Beatrix Potter and the characters she wrote about, drawn our own maps of cities and villages and composed music for a growing plant. We have written recounts of our village walk and consolidated addition and subtraction.
